

ARFA Senator e-Postal Rules

Announcing the AeroModeller ARFA Senator e-Postal event. Build the Free Full-Size Plan (in Issue 919), and fly anytime from Jan 1st through 31st October 2013.

Categories:

1) Juniors: (Under 18 years old in 2013) Fly any number of flights on any given day, record all scores, and send in your best 3 consecutive flights, 60-sec. Maximum (if you get 3 maxes in a row, every next flight made will also count, until you drop a flight (ie: less then 60 sec).

2) Intermediates: (Anyone irrespective of age) Fly any number of flights on any given day, record all scores, and send in your best 5 consecutive flights, 90-sec. Maximum (if you get 5 maxes in a row, every next flight made will also count, until you drop a flight (ie: less then 90 sec).

3) Experts: (You know who you are!) Fly any number of flights on any given day, record all scores, and send in your best 5 consecutive flights, 120 sec Maximum (if you get 5 maxes in a row, every next flight made will also count, until you drop a flight (ie: less then 120 sec).

4) Highest Flight Time: Also send in your single longest flight (whether one of your best "series" or not, timed to the ground or Out-of-Sight (OOS).

To ENTER: Send in your NAME and AGE, together with your FLIGHT SCORE, accompanied by a PHOTO image of entrant with their Senator (better do this first, just in case you OOS!).

Re-ENTRY: Enter as many times as you like on subsequent days, if your performance improves over the season — **Good Luck!**

WEBSITE: Entrants will be posted on the ADH AeroModeller website (but scores will not be revealed until the close of the contest 31st. October 2013).

WINNERS: Will be announced in Jan / Feb Issue, 2014
